# CORPUS CHRISTI KENNEL CLUB LONE STAR NOHS CONTEST

## ELIGIBILITY

Open to all dogs who meet the eligibility requirements of the AKC NOHS program and who are entered in the NOHS competition one or more days during the CCKC cluster. All rules pertaining to the AKC NOHS program apply.

## POINT SYSTEM

CCKC will assign points according to the following schedule to all winners of each breed's NOHS Best of Breed competition as well as Groups, Reserve BIS, and Best in Show competition on each of the four days of shows. The winner of the Contest will be the dog earning the greatest number of points over the four days. Dogs can be entered in any one, some, or all of the four shows; and they are not required to enter all four days. ***NO EXTRA ENTRY FEE IS REQUIRED.***

Each day's results will be tallied by the Corpus Christi Kennel Club, and a running total will be available for viewing at the Club's table beginning on Friday, January 11. The totals will be updated daily, and the special Contest prizes will be awarded immediately after NOHS Best in Show judging on Sunday, January 13. If the winner(s) has already gone home, the check(s) and rosette(s) will be mailed to the winner(s).

Should a tie occur in the total number of points between two or more dogs, the tie-breaker will be based on the greater number of the highest wins. Example: If the points of two or more dogs are tied after NOHS competition on Sunday, then the dog with the greater number of BIS awards will win. If still tied, then the dog with the greatest number of Reserve BIS awards will win. If still tied, then each Group win/placement through Best of Breed will be used as tie-breakers.

If the scores remain tied for NOHS Contest, the total prize money will be split equally among the winners. If the scores remain tied for Reserve NOHS Contest winner, the Reserve prize money will be split among those dogs who have tied scores.
